Registration Policies and Procedures

Residents will no longer be required to purchase recreation ID cards to participate in programs. However, ALL programs (Panther Hoops, Football, Cheerleading, Swimming Lessons, Swim team, Skating Lessons, Special Events, Soccer, Softball, Basketball, Volleyball, etc.) require that they provide 2 (two) proofs of Euclid residency to receive the resident rate of the individual program, at each time of registration.

1. Driver's License or State ID
2. Bank Statement
3. Utility Bill
4. School Report Card
5. Tax Bill
6. Voter Registration Card

Longfellow's WHALE Tales is a dry land (on the pool deck) water safety program. Longfellow's WHALE Tales is targeted at children ages 5-12, but all ages are welcome. American Red Cross Certified Water Safety Instructors will lead participants in interactive water safety activities daily at all pools during the 3:00 rest period and on Mondays and Wednesdays at Memorial Pool during the 7:00pm rest period. Each week will highlight a different topic and progress charts will be posted in the lobby of Memorial Pool and on bulletin boards at Neighborhood pools. Participants will sign in (preferably by 2:30pm and 6:30pm) at the guard office each day they choose to participate. At the end of summer each pool will have a "Whale of a Celebration" for all who participated.
